JUDGMENT ENTRY
APPOINTMENT OF A CONSERVATOR
[R.C. 2111.021]

Upon hearing the Application for Appointment of Conservator, the Court finds that the Petitioner is a resident of Greene County, Ohio, or has legal settlement in Greene County, Ohio; that this Court has jurisdiction, and that the Petitioner, _____, is a competent, but physically infirm adult, who has voluntarily petitioned for a Conservator to be appointed.

The Court hereby appoints _____, Conservator of the person person and estate estate of _____, and further grants to the Conservator powers fully described in the Order of Conservatorship.

The Court finds that the powers of the Conservator shall be:

- All powers that a guardian would have under the guardianship laws of the State of Ohio.
- Limited to the following powers, but not limiting the power to set bond and all powers in R.C. §2111.021.

The Court approves bond as filed.

The Court orders that an Order of Conservatorship be issued as provided by law.
