ENTRY REGARDING TERMINATION OF MINOR GUARDIANSHIP

Upon the Guardian's Application to Terminate Minor Guardianship, and for good cause shown, the Court orders as follows:

GUARDIANSHIP OF PERSON:

- The Court approves the Guardian's Application and terminates the guardianship of the person.
- The Court denies the Guardian's Application to terminate the guardianship of the person.
- The Court sets the matter for a hearing on the Application on _____, 20__ at ____ m.
The Guardian must appear at the hearing.

GUARDIANSHIP OF ESTATE:

- The Court approves the Guardian's Application and further orders:
 - The Guardian must file a final Guardian's Account within _____ days after the date of this Entry.
 - The Guardian must file a Statement in Lieu of Account within _____ days after the date this Entry.
 - The Guardian must file a Verification of Receipt and Deposit evidencing the minor's fund have been placed in an impounded account within _____ days after the date this Entry.
 - The Court dispenses with the filing of a final Guardian's Account.
- The Court denies the Guardian's Application to terminate the guardianship of the estate.
- The Court sets the matter for a hearing on the Application on _____, 20__ at ____ m.
The Guardian must appear at the hearing.

Termination of the guardianship of the minor's estate is subject to completion of all of the conditions set forth in this Entry. The Court will issue amended Letters of Guardianship, if necessary, to reflect the Court's orders.
