JUDGMENT ENTRY APPOINTING GUARDIAN AD LITEM
[Local Rule 66.2(H)]

This matter is before the Court upon the Application to Convert Minor Guardianship to Minor Trust. The Court finds that it is in the best interest of the minor to appoint a Guardian ad Litem to file a report and make a recommendation to the Court on behalf of the minor regarding the conversion of the minor guardianship of the estate to a minor trust under R.C. §2111.182. The Guardian ad Litem must also appear at the hearing on the Application.

The Court appoints _____ as Guardian ad Litem for the Minor. The Guardian ad Litem shall make arrangements to meet with the Minor, the Guardian, and the Applicant (if not the Guardian), and file a report with a recommendation at least ten days before the hearing on the Application. Upon the filing of the Guardian ad Litem's report, the Guardian ad Litem must submit a fee statement to the Court for approval. Fees for the Guardian ad Litem will be paid from the assets of the minor guardianship upon the Court's approval.
