**JUDGMENT ENTRY TERMINATING TESTAMENTARY TRUST  
SET FORTH IN DECEDENT'S WILL**  
[R.C. §2109.62; Local Rule 78.2(G)]

Upon review of the Motion to Terminate Testamentary Trust Set Forth in Decedent's Will, the Court finds that all necessary parties have either waived notice or have been properly served with notice and no objections to the termination of the testamentary trust were presented. The Court grants the Motion and orders that the testamentary trust set forth in the decedent's will shall be terminated pursuant to the provisions of R.C. §2109.62.

It is further ordered that

- The Fiduciary shall distribute the property pursuant to the terms of the trust outright to all beneficiaries who are adults.
- The Fiduciary shall distribute the property pursuant to the terms of the trust to any minor beneficiaries to a custodian as set forth in R.C. §5804.02.
- The Fiduciary shall distribute the property in accordance with their respective beneficial interests as follows:
