

GREENE COUNTY, OHIO - DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

When Must Dogs be Licensed

- Dogs must be licensed before they are 3 three months of age or within 30 days of acquiring the dog. Failure to license the dog within these requirements results in a penalty equal to the price of a one-year license.
- Licenses purchased after June 30th, when the dog was not required to be licensed by June 30th will receive a discount of \$10 off the cost of a one-year license or three-year license.

How to Acquire a Dog License

- Licenses may be purchased by mail from the Greene County Auditor’s Office, 69 Greene St., Xenia, OH 45385 or in person at either the Greene County Auditor’s Office or the Greene County Animal Control Office, 641 Dayton-Xenia Rd in Xenia.
- You can also register your dog on-line at www.doglicenses.us/OH/Greene. Credit card payments only; a per license processing fee applies.

Types of Licenses Available

Ohio law provides for a dog owner to purchase a one-year, three-year or permanent license. The following table indicates the cost of each type of license.
