DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

Under the supervision of the Highway Superintendent, a Foreman or working alone, this job provides a wide range of maintenance and construction operations. Work will include, not only the driving of trucks, both single axle and tandem axle, but also the ability to transport equipment to and from various job locations. Labor will be required for various other projects, including but not limited to, installing and repairing guardrail, placing asphalt, hand excavation, pipe laying, compaction, crack sealing, tree work, and other duties or jobs that may be assigned by the Engineer or Highway Superintendent.

Requires knowledge of snow and ice removal procedures including the location of county roads and route assignments. Also, requires knowledge of the area in regard to the location of various material sources and the ability to plan and use the best route for delivery of these materials to the required destination.

UNUSUAL WORKING CONDITIONS:

Exposure to extreme weather conditions, both hot and cold, as well as exposure to noise, dust and fumes. Ability to work in traffic. Strenuous physical exertion is to be expected. In addition, the person must have the flexibility to work long and staggered hours when needed. Snow and ice removal will require 12 hours shifts. On-call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Valid Ohio CDL, Class A with no restrictions. Must be familiar with hand and power tools and have the ability to operate them. Must also be familiar with working with some heavy and light equipment. Applicant must also be able to successfully pass Driver's License background check and pass a drug and alcohol screening test.
