## Filing Fees

Court Costs: \$89.00 plus \$1.00 per page for each page sent from the other court where the full

administration is filed.

## Requirements

Authenticated copies may be filed here when the decedent died a resident of Ohio, the estate was probated in a county other than Greene County, but the decedent owned real estate in Greene County, Ohio.

Note: All paperwork must be typed. We will not accept handwritten documents.

All filings must be single-sided. We will not accept double-sided originals.

Please do not staple original paperwork. We cannot accept filings with staples.

Authenticated copies of Decedent's Will and the Entry Admitting Will to Probate Court  O This is what we need if the decedent died with a will  O The documents must be authenticated from the court where the full administration is filed
Authenticated copy of Letters of Authority <i>If applicable</i> o This is what we need if the decedent died with <b>no</b> will  o The Letters must be authenticated from the court where the full administration is filed
Entry Admitting Foreign Records (GC Form 100.1E)
Contact Information Form (GC Form 75.3-A)
Self-Representation Acknowledgment (GC Form 75.1) <i>If applicable</i> o This form <b>must</b> be filed if applicant is not represented by an attorney.
